

Activity Name: *Such Great Joy*

Purpose: To watch and analyze concepts from a queer Jewish short film

Time: Half an hour to an hour

Materials: a TV, a DVD player, and a copy of *She Likes Girls 2* from Wolfe Video

Preparation: Load the DVD and cue it to the seventh film on the disc, "Such Great Joy"

Activity: Start by viewing the film. Afterwards, discuss using the questions below and/or some of your own.

### Discussion Questions

What part of the movie did you like the best?

How does Megan feel about coming out to her family? What does she do because of those feelings? Why do you think she feels this way? Can you relate to this feeling? How and why?

Megan mentions having met Christina at a "parade." What does this indicate about the level to which she is out?

At the beginning of the film, who knows that Megan is gay? Is it possible to be out in one part of your life but not in another? How does one negotiate this?

Why do you think this movie is called *Such Great Joy*? Whose joy is it referring to?
